## Transcript of a Notice dated 27 September 1799 by J.Jesson

Notice is hereby given that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the course of the next Sessions for leave to bring in a Bill for amending and extending the powers of the Acts passed in the sixth and tenth years of the Reign of His present Majesty for making and maintaining a navigable Cut or Canal from the River Severn between Bewdley and Titton Brook to the River Trent at or near Heywood in the County of Stafford. The said Bill being intended to give powers to make and maintain a navigable Canal from the Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal at or near Radford Bridge to or near the town of Stafford thro' the parishes of Berkswich otherwise Bassage and Castle Church otherwise Forebridge with other collateral Cuts and Reservoirs to supply the said Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal with water.
